

Brokered Training



Approach

- IMTARC searches out multiple private and public training service providers that offer training/education relevant to the SB&R sector and forges a service provision relationship.
- IMTARC canvasses SB&R sector and determines interest in particular training/education offered by training service providers and based on interest, organizes and schedules training either at IMTARC or at remote location.
- IMTARC also receives input from SB&R sector on need for particular training/education and then researches and locates appropriately qualified training service provider.

The Value-Added Component

- **Cost Saving** for course participants and their employers through economies of scale by filling up classrooms
- **Greater Learning Opportunities** for course participants as they come from large, medium and small employers from private and public sectors in the industry. As much is learned from the networking and expression of different perspectives in the classroom as from the curriculum itself.
- **Lack of Diversions** for course participants by removing them from the workplace and placing them in a dedicated training environment. No distractions.
- **Training Organization and Administration** handled by IMTARC thus allowing employers to focus on operations.
